## Donation Agreement

All Horses donated to Last Chance Corral ("Last Chance") are donated without any restrictions pertaining to their use. Generally, following their donation, horses are examined to determine what, if any, rehabilitative treatment is required. Following such treatment as Last Chance, in its sole discretion, deems necessary, horses are put up for adoption. Any adoption fees paid as a result of such adoption are expenses incurred by Last Chance in connection with its treatment and boarding of the horses.

Last Chance may, in its discretion, elect to sell selected horses which have been received as a tax write off/fund raiser, to third parties with all the proceeds from such sales, after the payment of appropriate commissions, if any, to be used by Last Chance for financing its corporate purposes.

If a horse is pregnant at the time of its donation, any resulting offspring shall be the property of Last Chance. Donors acknowledge that, as a last resort may have to euthanize this horse. This is determined by a veterinarian according to the severity of the horses' medical problems.

Last Chance is exempt from Federal Income Tax under section 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code (the "Code") as an organization described in section 501(c)(3) of the Code. Consequently, you may wish to consult with your tax consultant regarding the deductibility of your donation to Last Chance.

Upon receipt of your donation, Last Chance agrees, subject to the foregoing, to provide for the boarding and health care of the horse. Last Chance further agrees to adhere to all relevant federal and Ohio laws pertaining to animal welfare.

No horse will be accepted for donation by Last Chance without receipt of this fully completed donation agreement form. The horse's registration papers, medical history, and other pertinent history, if any, should accompany it at the time of donation. Donors who import horses from out of state must meet Ohio import requirements.
